Longevity

Longevity bonuses will be paid at the end of the tenth, fifteenth, twentieth, twenty-fifth, thirtieth, thirty-fifth and fortieth years at the following rates (prorated for part time):

After 10 years of service: 2.5% of the 10th year base salary

After 15 years of service: 5% of the 15th year base salary

After 20 years of service: 7.5% of the 20th year base salary

After 25 years of service: 10% of the 25th year base salary

After 30 years of service: an additional increment of \$1750

After 35 years of service: an additional increment of \$1750

After 40 years of service: an additional increment of \$1750

Differentials

Signing - Unit members who are assigned to a position that requires signing after having passed a signing examination or is otherwise certified shall receive a differential equivalent to a two (2) range increase in base pay (current range and step).

Bilingual - Unit members who are assigned to a position that requires bilingual skills after having passed the bilingual examination shall receive a differential equivalent to a two (2) range increase in base pay (current range and step).

Braille - Unit members who are assigned to a position that requires Braille skills after having passed a Braille examination shall receive a differential equivalent to a two (2) range increase in base pay (current range and step).

CELDT - Unit members who are assigned to the duties of coordinating CELDT testing and training shall receive a differential equivalent to a two (2) range increase in base pay (current range and step).

Specialized Health Care - Unit members who perform Specialized Health Care procedures after being certified by the School Nurse shall receive a differential equivalent to two (2) ranges above their base pay (current range and step).

Emergency Specialized Health Care - Unit members who are certified and are identified to perform Specialized Health Care procedures for rectal Diastat or emergency anti-seizure medications shall receive a differential equivalent to two (2) ranges above their base pay (current range and step).

There shall be an overall cap on differential pay equivalent to five (5) ranges regardless of differential services performed. Differentials are prorated based on the unit member's percentage of assignment.

If a unit member is on an extended leave because of industrial injury or extended medical illness/injury leave, the unit member will be paid his/her base salary without the differential(s). Extended leave is defined as an absence of twenty (20) or more workdays within any thirty- (30) workday period. Upon his/her return from an extended leave to an assignment requiring differential service(s), such differential(s) will be reinstated.

Shift Differential - five percent (5%) prorated for regular positions of 5 hours or more per day night shift.

Special Project - 2 range differential prorated to the classified employee's percentage of assignment.

Master's Degree

Unit members who have attained a Master's Degree from an institution accredited by a recognized regional accrediting agency shall be awarded a differential of \$700.00, prorated based on the unit member's percentage of assignment.

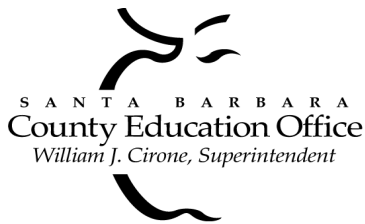
